

MANAGEMENT CHALLENGE

The Management Challenge, held annually, is a simulation-based team building, learning and networking program using real local government themes – the types of issues that a senior management team in a council would most likely face. The teams, made of up to six team members, are challenged to respond to a series of tasks in a unique one-day, fast paced, 'pressure cooker' environment. Some tasks will require written responses (such as a council report or recommendation document), some will take the form of role plays or presentations and the teams are also scored on observations of how well they display energy, synergy, effectiveness and creative thinking. It provides an opportunity for team members to develop their skills and become more effective in the way they operate.

The Australasian Management Challenge has been at the forefront of professional development in local government in Australia and New Zealand for more than 25 years. In that time, many thousands of local government professionals have been given the opportunity to participate, grow, be challenged and learn alongside their team members and peers. Many have subsequently gone on to senior management roles.

The 2024 Management Challenge will be held on Thursday 11 April 2024. The winner will be announced at the LG Professionals SA 23rd Annual Leadership Excellence Awards Gala Dinner on Friday 10 May 2024.

RURAL MANAGEMENT CHALLENGE

The Rural Management Challenge, held biennially, is a simulation-based team building, learning and networking program using real local government themes – the types of issues that a senior management team in a council would most likely face – and is tailored to regional councils. The teams, made up of four team members, are challenged to respond to a series of tasks in a unique one-day, fast paced, 'pressure cooker' environment.

Though incorporating many similar elements to the Management Challenge, the Rural Management Challenge is tailored to a regional council context, with consideration given to the different resources and complexities faced by regional councils. The event concludes with a dinner where the winner is announced.

The winning team will receive 6 tickets (for each team member, their mentor & CEO) to attend the 2024 Leadership Excellence Awards Gala Dinner where they will be officially presented with the winner's trophy.

The 2023 Rural Management Challenge will be held on Thursday 19 October 2023 – subject to a minimum number of teams being met.
